We need a volunteer to drive the church van to pick up people on the 4th Sundays of the month. If you are interested or have any questions please contact Tom Kroll or the church office.

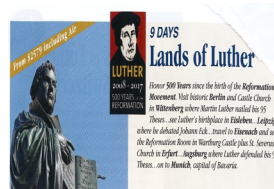
