Biblesticks for our Military

On Sunday, Nov. 12th, Cottage 15 will be having what we call our “kick-off Sunday” whereby we will be collecting money to purchase audio type Bibles for people serving in our military. They are called BibleSticks. The BibleStick is a small device (about the size of a pack of gum) so it can easily be taken with them as they travel into sometimes unsettled and dangerous places. They don’t have to read just listen to words of hope and encouragement as they are far away from home. The cost is \$25 per Biblestick. It is our goal to purchase 100 of them. If \$25 is more than you care to give, any amount is greatly appreciated. Please make checks payable to St. Mark Lutheran Church. A door offering will be taken on Sunday, Nov. 12th and Thursday, Nov. 16th. We will also have a table set up in the narthex before and after worship services. Let’s give to those who sacrifice so much for us. Thanks for helping with this worthy cause.
