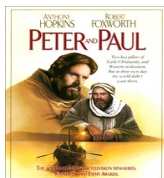

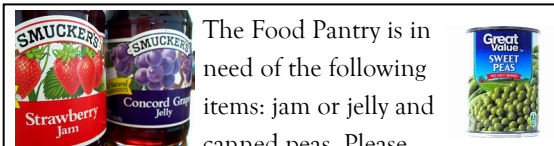

Cost is \$65 per person.

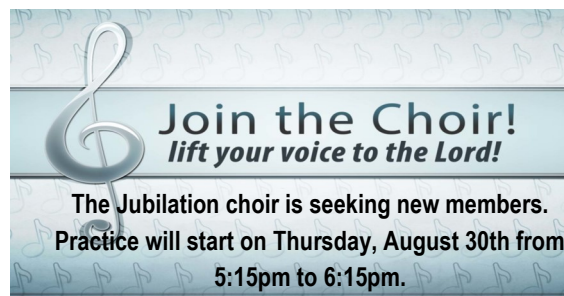
We won't be tailgating, but bring chairs if you want to socialize.

Tickets are available now until the beginning of September from Dave Hilpertshauser or Chris Keul.

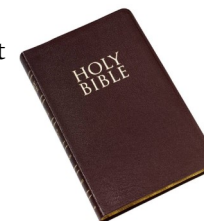
