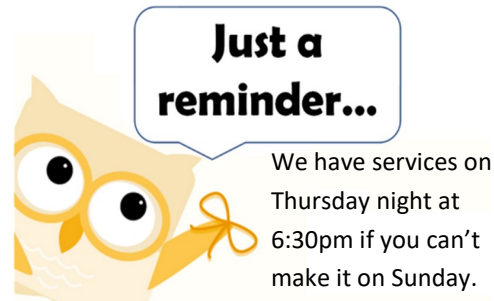

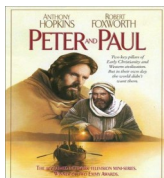

The game is at 6:20pm, the bus will leave promptly at 2pm.

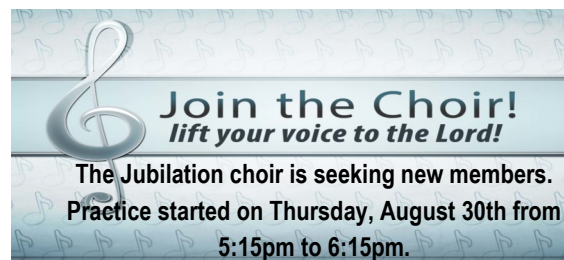
Cost is \$65 per person.

Tickets are available now until the beginning of September from Dave Hilpertshauser or Chris Keul.

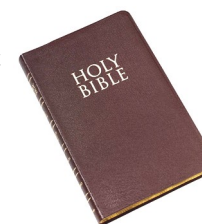
