Ronald McDonald House Charities don't administer medical care. They keep millions of children and families close to the critical care they need - and to each other. They provide places of respite for parents, space for children to be children, and communities of support for all family members dealing with a child's medical crisis. They also help alleviate some financial burdens for families with sick children. To date they have helped families save more over \$443 million in hotel and meal expenses by collecting aluminum tabs. There is a now a plastic bottle in the Narthex to collect the tabs.
