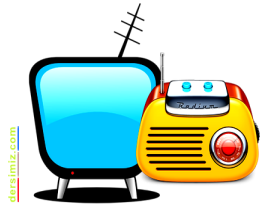

**Making Spirits Bright**

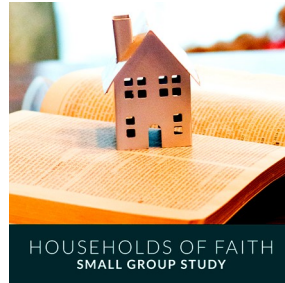
We are fortunate to, again have the first night **(November 27th)** designated as **“St Mark Night.”**
